

White Rose Candles

Burning your White Rose Candle

1. On initially lighting the candle, it may be 2-4 hours before a smell is noticed. On subsequent burnings, the aroma will appear within a few minutes.
2. Expect the candle to burn with a smallish flame. This makes the candle last longer, and produces a stronger aroma.
3. Expect the candle to burn hollow - you will be left with a hollow shell when the candle is finally burned out.
4. To relight the candle when it is partially burned hollow, hold the candle horizontally. Take a freshly-lit match between the first and second fingers, and hold it just below the wick. Take care not to break off the charred end of the wick as this may make it difficult to relight.
5. Where possible, allow the candle to burn for several hours each time it is lit. If the candle is burnt only for short periods, it may “drown” the wick and make it difficult to relight.
6. If the wick is “drowned” and the candle is burning with a very small flame, pour out some of the melted wax into a non-flammable container, and allow to cool before disposal.

⚠ Never leave a burning candle unattended.

⚠ Keep away from things that can catch fire.
